a.	<p>TASK & PURPOSE:</p> <p>Assist in implementation of Pathfinder Missions including liaison with a civilian Pathfinders Task Force (TF). The TF focuses on outreach missions to any disaster's <u>homebound</u> victims, especially seniors and persons with disabilities. The TF uses a grid search pattern with GPS tracking and info system which can collect, document, and collate electronic data for street address mapping of a host of special needs. Uses 5 Strike Teams with 7 squads each for initial Ops; fulfills special needs with another 5 squads. The TF provides reports for real time and future analysis by SEOC planners when the TF is supplied with sophisticated Satellite Communication Support by a co-deployed civilian Pathfinders Task Force.</p> <p>The TF specializes in merging ESF functions into a local/state/federal Unified Command which can combine National Guard under Title 32, civilians, and volunteers into a self-supporting TF.
